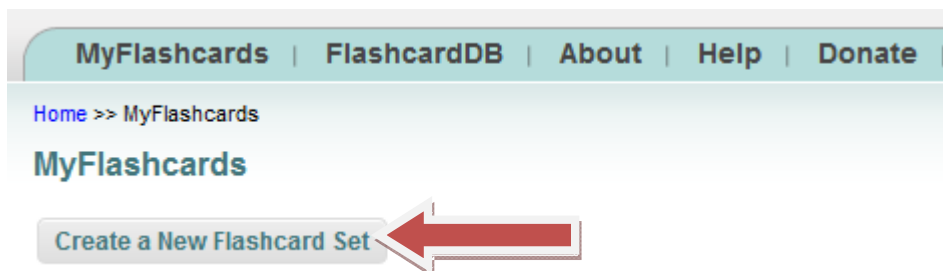


Flashcard Machine Instructions

1. Log-in to your account. Click **Create a New Flashcard Set**.



2. On the Create a New Set screen, use the pull-down arrow by **Subject** to select **Education** and the pull-down arrow beside **Grade Level** to select your grade. Next to **Title**, type the name of the reading selection and next to **Description**, type the section of the reading selection, such as Chapter 1 or the page numbers. Format the font that you would like to use. Click **Enabled** on the next two choices so that others will be able to use your set of completed flashcards. Last of all, click the button **Save Set Details**. Now under sharing you will see the URL for your flashcard set. This can be used to linked to our class wiki.

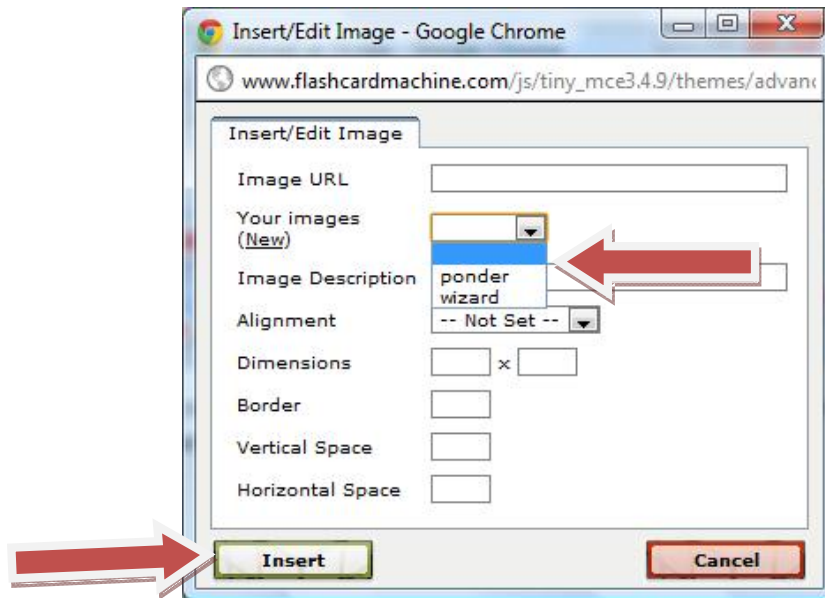
7. This opens the **Insert/Edit Image** box. Underneath the choice **Your images** click **(New)**.



8. This opens the **Upload an Image** box. Click the Choose File button and locate where you saved the image. In the box beside **Image Name**, type a short description of your image. Click the **Upload Image** button.



9. This will take you back to the **Insert/Edit Image** box. Click the pull-down arrow beside **Your images** and choose the file you have just uploaded. Click **Insert** and the image will now appear on the first side of the flashcard.



10. Next type the vocabulary word either above or below the image.

11. In the bottom box, type the definition of the word. You have now completed the first card.

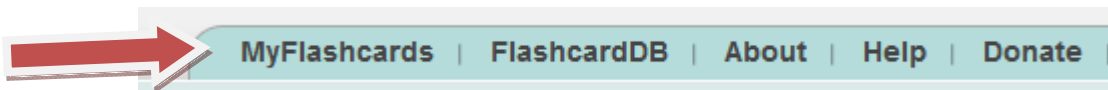
