

## Fahrenheit 451 Doodle

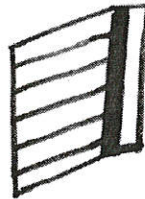

Why or why not?



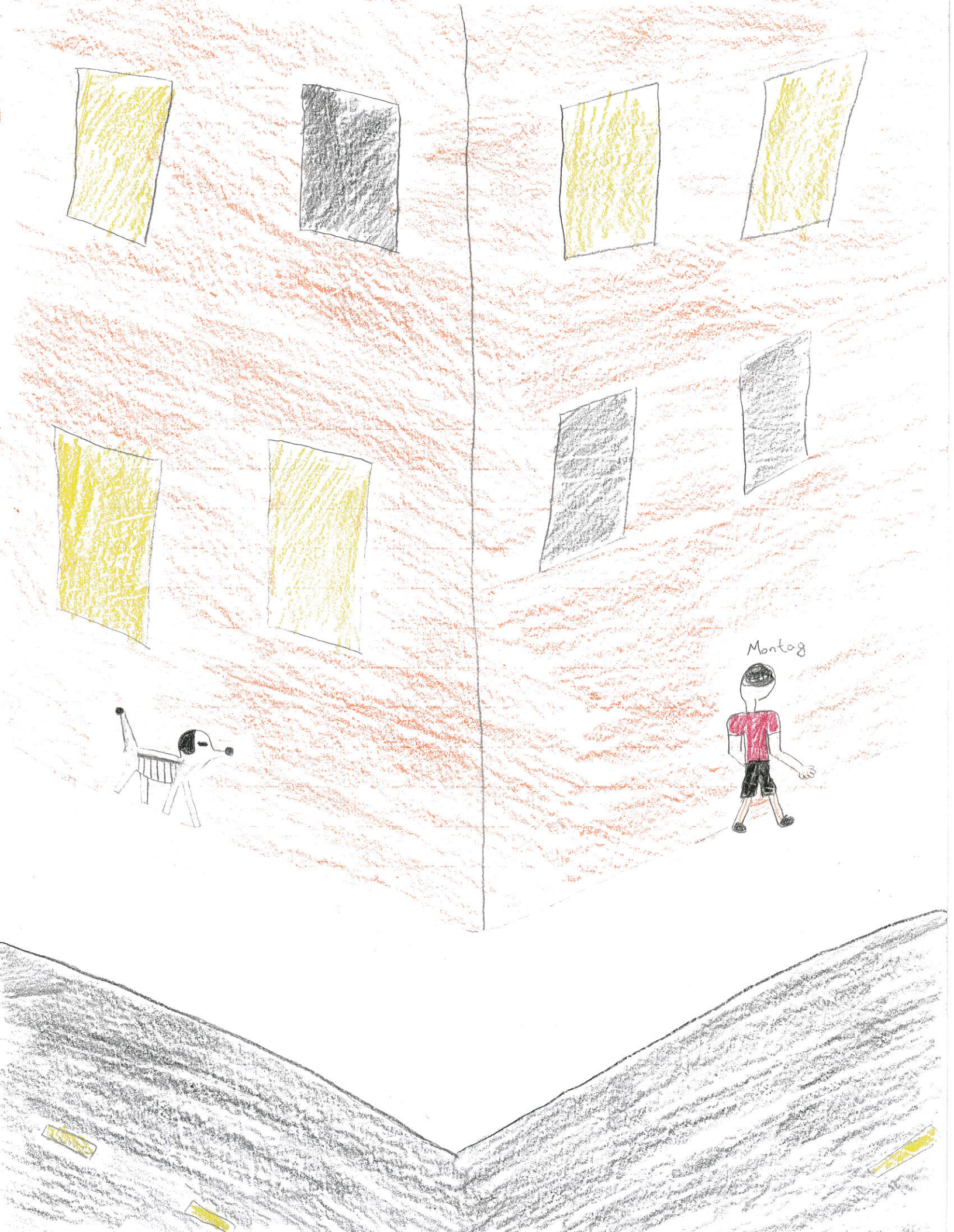
The Doodle to use is:
