After you have performed your choral reading and received feedback from your peers, write a one- to two-paragraph reflection that assesses the work you and your group have done. Listed below are questions to consider as you write and reflect. You do not have to address all of these questions, nor do you have to address them in the order they are listed. Focus on the questions/issues that are most relevant to an honest and thoughtful reflection of your work.

- What did you discover about theme and/or character in putting together your choral reading?
- How did you attempt to communicate that finding in your choral reading?
- What risks as performers did your group take in choreographing your choral reading?
- What did you think worked well in your choral reading?
- What would you do differently if you could perform the choral reading again?
