

Guidelines for Teaching about Your Topic

GOAL: To teach the rest of the class what you learned about the Gold Rush.

Your group may choose the activity you want to use to teach the class what you have learned.

Any of the following suggestions may be used, or you can propose an idea of your own. Please make sure that the teacher approves this choice before you begin working.

Activity Suggestions:

- oral presentation
- pamphlet/brochure advertising for the town
- newspaper written about all aspects of the Gold Rush
- poster
- research paper/essay
- trivia game
- your own proposed and approved activity

Requirements for the activity:

- include main ideas and details about the topic.
- include up to five important vocabulary words.
- include hand-drawn illustrations and/or photographs.
- include two or three interesting facts.
