<b>Voice - Consistency</b>	Voice quality is clear and consistently audible throughout the presentation.	Voice quality is clear and consistently audible throughout the majority (85-95%) of the presentation	Voice quality is clear and consistently audible through some (70-84%) of the presentation. <b>Voice - Pacing</b>	The pace (rhythm and voice punctuation) fits the story line and helps the audience really "get into" the story.	Occasionally speaks too fast or too slowly for the story line. The pacing (rhythm and voice punctuation) is relatively engaging for the audience. <b>Images</b>	Images are appealing, highly relevant, and add support to the argument.	Visuals are appealing and add support to the argument.	An attempt was made to use images to related to the topic but it needed more work.	Little or no attempt to use images that were directly related to the topic.
<b>Grammar</b>	Grammar and usage are correct.	Grammar and usage are mostly correct.	Errors in grammar and usage detract from story frequently.	Errors in grammar and usage distract greatly from the story.
<b>Music</b>	Music stirs a rich emotional response that matches the argument well.	Music stirs a rich emotional response that somewhat matches the argument.	Music is adequate, and not distracting, but it does not add much to the argument.	Music is distracting or inappropriate or missing.
<b>Duration of Presentation</b>	The presentation lasted between 2:25 and 2:35 minutes.	The presentation was between 2:36 and 2:45 minutes OR between 2:24 and 2:15 minutes.	The presentation was between 2:46 and 2:55 minutes OR between 2:14 and 2:05 minutes.	The presentation was over 2:56 minutes or under 2:04 minutes.
