| Text Connections | Makes unexpected but clear connections to others' texts to extend the story in interesting and surprising directions. | Uses links that connect to classmates' wikis in ways that forward and develop that story. Classmates' wikis become part of your wiki story. | Makes basic connections/links within own text to create story that has more than one character that, in some way, connect together. Uses the phrase "It wasn't supposed to be that far away." |
| Links | Includes a variety of important links that are well planned and creatively placed. Links include Internet, own wiki, and classmates' wikis. | Includes a variety of links, including links to the Internet that are appropriate sources for the story. | Includes at least one link to another page of their own wiki following the basic instructions provided. |
| Images/Graphics | Includes images that are an important part of the wiki and add strong detail. Use of images contributes to the story meaning in significant ways. Images are linked to other wikis. | Includes images/graphics that are closely linked to the story. | Includes images/graphics from the Internet that are not closely linked to the story, or does not include any images or graphics. |
| Writing and Process | Wiki text shows relationships with other links and perspectives. The text and links flow and make sense to the reader. Wiki is completed but is also a text that will constantly change as a part of a bigger system. | Wiki text uses student's voice and personal ideas and demonstrates strong relationships to other links. Wiki has been created through many revisions and changes. | Wiki text uses student's voice and personal ideas. Wiki has been created in the time allowed and is close to a finished product. |
