

KEY FACTS ABOUT ROBERT FROST



- Robert Frost was born in San Francisco on March 26, 1874.
- After his father's death, Frost moved to New England with his mother and sister. He was 11 years old at the time.
- Frost married and had four children. He wanted to write poetry, but also needed to earn money to support his family.
- His grandfather agreed to buy him a farm if Frost would work the farm for 10 years. During the day, he did chores associated with the farm. At night, he wrote poetry.
- He sold the farm and moved his family to a small country farmhouse in England. He took 30 poems to a publisher in London. The publisher accepted his poems and published them as a book in 1913.
- The Frost family returned to New England in 1914.
