2. Illustrate your haiku using colored pencils, crayons or watercolor paints.
3. At home or in the library, find some INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC that would fit your poem well. If you would like to compose your own music to fit your haiku, please bring the recording to class.

(Example: If you play a musical instrument or want to make musical sounds with natural objects to enhance your haiku, feel free to do so.)

4. Bring in your selection of music to class, and be ready to present your haiku along with the music you selected.
