## Additional Ideas for the Computer Center

- To save time and eliminate distractions, be sure to bookmark in advance the exact page you want your students to access.
- Some sites have more pop-up advertisements than others. If your students are distracted by those pop-up ads and may accidentally click on them, you may want to select a site that has fewer advertisements.
- Most importantly, be sure to evaluate completely in advance any page your students will access to ensure that its content is appropriate for your classroom.
- If you have evaluated a Web site far in advance, check the site again just before students use the center, because Web content often changes.
