## **Choral Reading**

Objective: To develop reading fluency in a meaningful context

Materials: Any genre will work, but this technique is especially effective with

poetry.

## Procedure:

1. Prepare to read by discussing the setting that might be appropriate for the material to be read. Ask students to describe it and make personal connections and associations.

- 2. Decide who should read the selection
  - Whole group
  - Individuals
  - Pairs
  - Alternating sections
  - Boys
  - Girls
- 3. Decide how the selection should be read
  - Loudly
  - Softly
  - Rapidly
  - Slowly
  - Melodiously
  - Angrily
  - Giggling
  - Seriously
  - Other
- 4. Have each student, pair, whole group, or determined grouping practice reading assigned parts until the parts are read smoothly and with expression.
- 5. Perform before an audience ... another class, the students' families, for morning announcements, or by recording it.
