sandwich

sandwich (sānd' wīch, sān' -), *n.* (The two pieces of bread.) With the fingertips of the right hand facing the body, the left hand is placed atop the other and both are brought up to the mouth, which opens slightly.



smirk (bad smile)

bad (bād), *adj.* (Tasting something, finding it unacceptable, and turning it down.) The tips of the right hand are placed at the lips, and then the hand is thrown down.



smile (smīl), *v.* smiled, smiling, *n.* (Drawing the lips into a smile.) The right index finger is drawn back over the lips toward the ear. As the finger moves back, the signer breaks into a smile. (Both index fingers may also be used.)

zesty (delicious)

delicious *adj.* (Licking the fingers.) Touch the thumb to the middle finger and bring to the lips. Then rub the thumb down the middle finger as the hand is pulled away from the mouth.
