
Vocabulary Sign Sheet—*Sam's Sandwich*

shriek (shout)

shout (shout), v. shouted, shouting. (Harsh words thrown out.) The right hand appears to claw words out of the mouth. Then it turns and throws them out.



drool

drool (drōol), v. drooled, drooling (The saliva drips from the corner of the mouth.) The index finger of the right "4" hand moves down from its position against the mouth's right corner. The mouth is held slightly open, and the tip of the tongue may protrude.



snatch

snatch up (*colloq.*), v. (Sleight of hand.) The downturned hand is positioned at chest height, with the index and middle finger pointing to the left. With a quick and sudden movement, the hand moves right and the two fingers bend.



Vocabulary Sign Sheet—*Sam's Sandwich* (continued)

slimy (wet and dirty)

wet (wĕt), *adj.* The right fingertips touch the lips, and then the fingers of both hands close against the thumbs as both hands are lowered.



dirty (dûr' fī), *adj.* The downturned right hand is placed under the chin. Its fingers, pointing left, wiggle repeatedly.



wail (cry)

cry v. (Tears falling.) The index finger on each hand should touch the face near the eyes and then move downward, as tears would.
