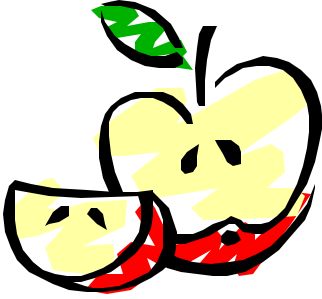

Use this organizer to write your own cinquain.
