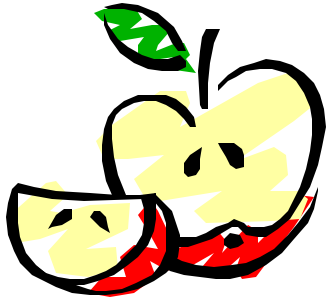

Cinquain Graphic Organizer

A cinquain is a five-line poem that describes a person, place, or thing.



Apple
Red, Shiny
Biting, Chewing, Bobbing
Do Not Eat the Seeds
Snack!

Use this organizer to write your own cinquain.
