Satirical Techniques¹	Student identifies six or more satirical techniques in the examples.	Student identifies four to five satirical techniques in the examples. Related Commentary or Criticism	Student accurately identifies the commentary or criticism made in the text and connects the examples and satirical techniques to that theme.	Student accurately identifies the commentary or criticism made in the text and connects the theme to either the examples or the satirical techniques.	Student accurately identifies the commentary or criticism made in the text, but explanation of the connection to examples and techniques is weak.	Student has difficulty identifying the commentary or criticism made in the text.

¹ Typical satirical techniques include exaggeration, incongruity, parody, or reversal.
