<b>Alliteration in Acrostic Poetry</b>	Words in the acrostic poem do not begin with the same initial sounds	A few words in the acrostic poem demonstrate alliteration	Most of the word pairs demonstrate alliteration and make sense in the poem	All of the word pairs use alliteration and make sense in the poem	
<b>Alliteration in Alphabet or Number Book</b>	Alliteration is not used in creating the text for the project	A few pages use alliteration	Most pages use alliteration	All pages use alliteration	
<b>Alliteration in Tongue Twisters</b>	Student's writing does not use alliteration	Some alliteration is used	Most of the tongue twisters use three or more words with the same initial sounds	All tongue twisters use alliteration, and more than three words begin with the same initial sounds
