

Literature Circles with Film Roles – Production Designer

In the movies, the production designer creates the look and feel of both the setting and costumes. In this role, you will be finding pictures that illustrate what you feel the setting looks like. In addition, you will be designing a costume for an actor to wear while playing a character from the reading.

1. Using magazines, cut out pictures that you feel capture the setting as described in the story.
2. Write a paragraph showing the connection between that picture and the text.
3. Choose one of the characters in the book. Which actor could play that character in a movie-version?
4. Describe the costume you would design for this character. How is the costume appropriate for this character?
5. Write a paragraph or two describing not only the character, but also the actor selected and the type of costume.
