GOAL

- Your goal is to prepare a character from the text you've read for a job in the real world.
- The problem/challenge for the job search will be overcoming any weaknesses that the character demonstrates in the text.

ROLE

- You are the head of an employment agency that finds jobs for unemployed people.
- You have been asked to help a character from the text that you've read prepare a resume and perfect interview skills.
- Your ultimate goal is to get the character a job.

AUDIENCE

- Your client is a specific character from a text that you've read.
- The target audience for the resume is prospective employers.
- The target audience for the interview questions is specific character, who will need to understand the questions and how to present himself or herself in an interview.
- You need to convince these employers to hire the character, and you need to convince the character that she or he is employable.

SITUATION

- The context you find yourself in is the real world.
- The challenge involves dealing with the character's weaknesses and the tough business world.

PRODUCT OR PERFORMANCE

You will create a resume for a fictional character and an Interview Sheet (with at least 10 questions and answers), which focuses on questions the character might face in a job interview. Your interview questions should focus on the types of in-depth questions that an employer would ask someone applying for a specific job. The questions should be go deeper than merely "What is your name?" and should be designed so that the employer is able to get to know the character better as a future employee. You will then prepare suitable responses to the employee questions, some of which may be difficult, for the character to use as a reference while preparing for the interview.
